BISHKEK - (AP) The head of Kyrgyzstan's interim government, Roza Otunbayeva, said the deposed president must face trial, rescinding an earlier offer of security guarantees for him. Otunbayeva and others had earlier offered ousted President Bakiyev a safe passage out of the country if he resigned voluntarily. Bakiyev, speaking to Russian media from his home Jalal-Abad region in southern Kyrgyzstan, urged the United Nations to send peacekeepers to Kyrgyzstan to prevent unrest from spreading.
