AMMAN (AFP) - Jordanian Prime Minister Samir Rifai reshuffled his cabinet on July 28, dropping six ministers and replacing them with seven others. The ministers of justice, education, agriculture, tourism, information and cabinet affairs left the government, while Labour Minister Ibrahim Omush changed his portfolio to become state minister for prime ministry and legal affairs. Seven new members entered the government, after they were sworn in by King Abdullah II.
