Dear Mr. Crowley,

I left you a message and look forward to talking, but here's the short version.

One of our Pakistani stringers, [redacted] has been the object of harrassment by the ISI, to the point where we have flown him out of the country for his own safety. Both [redacted] have heard from Pakistani contacts that the ISI was "looking for" [redacted] Both [redacted] wife and [redacted] a colleague in our Islamabad Bureau, have had calls from the ISI.

I understand that the State Department's influence with ISI is limited at best, but I wanted to get this situation on the department's radar, and urge you to take any steps you can think of to discourage this menacing treatment of an honorable and talented journalist, so that he can return to Pakistan and his work without fear.
