The Secretary had a conversation with Senator Levin today about Jackson/Vanik – Levin told her that the Administration has been opposed to his efforts to lift the Jackson Vanik restrictions pertaining to Russia. He said that Administration officials have been telling him that the Russians don't want them lifted.
