Colleagues,

MFA Arms Control Dept. Director Sun Lei informed me at 1830 pm that, "in light of the current situation, China has decided to postpone the consultations with Robert Einhorn" scheduled for July 20-21. Sun added that China attached importance to these consultations but the U.S. should clearly know why China is postponing them, and that "the responsibility is not on the Chinese side." He said that we cannot request cooperation on issues of concern to the U.S. while not cooperating on issues of concern to China. I noted that the issues Mr. Einhorn would discuss are of concern not only to the U.S., but also to China and many other countries.
