Subject: Libya - Medical Assistance

We believe Secretary Panetta remains interested in announcing any medical assistance initiative we will be taking re Libya. He would be able to do so with the press now travelling with him on the Asia trip. We are following developments on this through AFRICOM and USD/P. Tom Davis at AFRICOM will handle any press issues in theatre. John Kirby is OSD/PA's point of contact on this, and will need to know if/when we are ready to make any announcement; he will work through George Little, travelling with SecDef, to get appropriate TPs and context to the Secretary. We are, of course, holding for green lights from appropriate entities -- but just wanted to remind you all of this so SecDef is the one announcing rather than reading about it.
