I wanted to update everyone on the progress of a policy speech Raj is going to deliver next Thursday, the 20th, on economic growth. He's delivering the speech here at the Ronald Reagan Building, during an event highlighting our history of public-private partnerships.

The speech will lay out the evolution of development assistance, its role in generating economic growth and how the development community now needs to adopt a much more private sector-oriented approach to development in the years ahead.
