Its 0430 and our team has just concluded a long evening of negotiations with the Chinese side. Although the deliberations were very tough at times, I think we have arrived at a final agreement that we believe will be acceptable. We will need to incorporate the economic language once Mike is done, and I expect that it is possible that VFM Cui may come back with one or two minor changes at the last.
