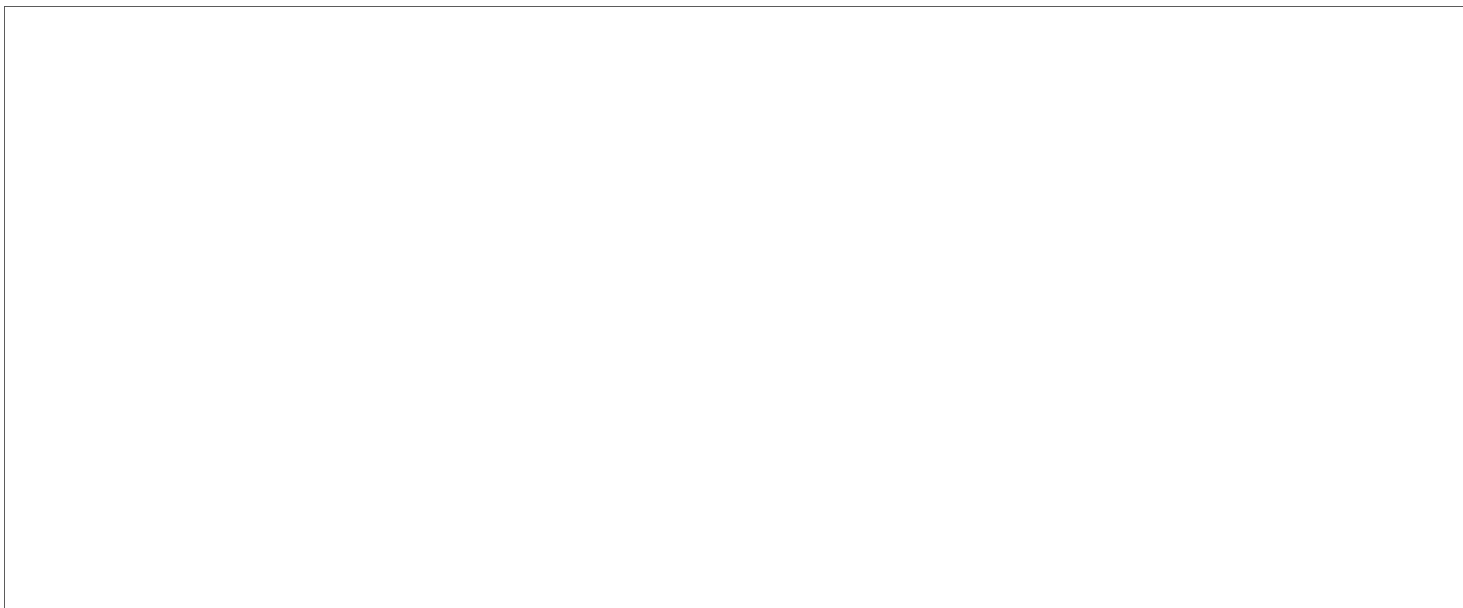

I’ve included below additional Russia specific talking points and further readout on where things landed in NYC at the end of the day. I know it is the middle of the night your time and am hoping you will get this in the morning, but given time zones, I wanted this to be top of your queue. With many thanks for all you have done and for the super fast and very timely readout from Laura (who has gone above and beyond and allowed us to get readouts to SER twice right as she was walking into PR meetings). I’ll update throughout the night as negotiations at P3 are ongoing in NYC. – Erica

- **Additional Russia-specific Talking points**

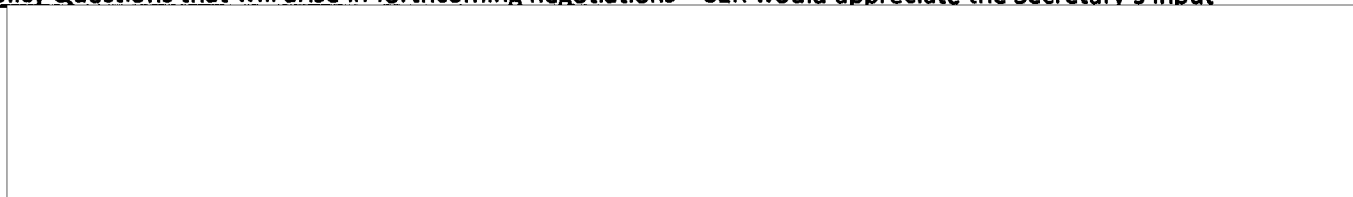




**Calls being made by others**
