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Berry is one of the Congressional pro-life Democrats who signed several letters in recent months to Speaker Pelosi asking her to allow a vote on an amendment to strike the abortion funding provision in any legislation. Rules Chairwoman Slaughter has said members will not be permitted to offer amendments to the bill, except for a Republican substitute amendment. Any last-minute changes in the bill will be offered as part of the resolution governing floor debate.

- In addition to abortion funding, Berry takes issue with the claim that the regional disparities language in the bill is done. He does not believe rural hospitals will get a good reimbursement rate under the plan outlined in the bill. This is his main substantive problem.
- Berry also believes the legislation should contain a minimum reimbursement for doctors that is equal to the national average.
- Like many others, Berry is concerned about how the legislation's reforms would be paid for. He has said publicly that wants to see more money taken from the drugmakers and insurance industry. "If they aren't squealing to the high heavens, we haven't hit them hard enough," he has told reporters.
- Berry reportedly understands and appreciates how historic this moment is. He has said that he knows "something needs to get done". For that reason, he has indicated that he is entirely dug in and resigned to voting "no."
