The air pressure caused the meal packages to inflate so they floated to the ground. They did that every night for months w/out any injuries on the ground, feeding thousands of people. He's asked the Air Force to plan to do that here, and I urged him to push for the decision to be made to try this by Tuesday night. He's also told Gates and Mullen about this and expressed surprise that no one else recalled it being done.

I told Gen. Jones I was going to tell you about it so we could consider and assist in execution if plan went forward. Please find out if anybody at AID knows about this and reach out to the military (probably Gen. Keen) to discuss. And let me know so I can help push.
