In regards to the campaign for women, we've got a great team and plan ready to go, but haven't been able to get the necessary startup funding.

We've approached a few potential private investors, but they want to know State is formally committed before they say yes. We have been working closely with Melanne for months, Kris Balderston is being helpful, and Raj's office has suggested they may be able to assist -- but so far nothing has come of it.

\$400k in startup capital is needed to get it off the ground. We have a draft MOU and funding proposal in at State, but have not heard back. We need to get going this month if we are to have an event and web site ready by September for Beijing+15.

As I understand things, you can help move it along by making it a clear priority to Jack Lew, who can carve out the money to get it done quickly.
