Congress

Jack, Rich and Barbara Retzlaff met with yesterday to discuss our budget preferences. seemed hostile to our requests for Afghanistan and Iraq, though that's probably because of Leahy's views on the conflicts in general; he was non-committal on the substance of our requests.

Afghanistan

deMistura and Karzai have issued their respective statements on the PSCs according to the plan; Eikenberry has just finished his press conference to explain the U.S. view in greater detail. Jack said if the PSC issue is not resolved satisfactorily, it will endanger our funding (above).

Iraq

Jack asked Pat to explore with DoD whether it can help with "gap-fillers" after December 31.

Indonesia

Tsunami death toll now at 262 with more than 400 missing. Amcit found alive. No request from Indonesians for assistance.

<u>India</u>

Indians signed the CSC in Vienna as promised today. Bill will brief on President's trip at WH press briefing today (still not briefed to Hill).

<u>Mexico</u>

Jim Steinberg will use his meeting with Espinosa today to persuade withdrawal of resolution language at UNVIE casting aspersions on US-Russian nuclear disarmament policies.
