I am pleased to tell you that we concluded the GLOC MOU, for real this time. The language in Section 8 accepted was our "option 1."

The Minister of Law and Justice will review and they are trying to expedite a Cabinet meeting for POSSIBLY tomorrow, more likely Monday. They are trying to get this done on their end so Ambassador Munter can sign before he leaves. It will be tight, but possible.
