Subject: Suicide Bomber Attacks PRT Asadabad Vehicle (SBU)

(SBU) DS Command reports a COM vehicle movement from PRT Asadabad traveling under U.S. military protection was struck by a possible suicide bomber at approximately 0130 EDT/1000 local. One COM employee was injured and one remains unaccounted for. DS Command reports there may be up to five military personnel killed and five wounded in the attack.
