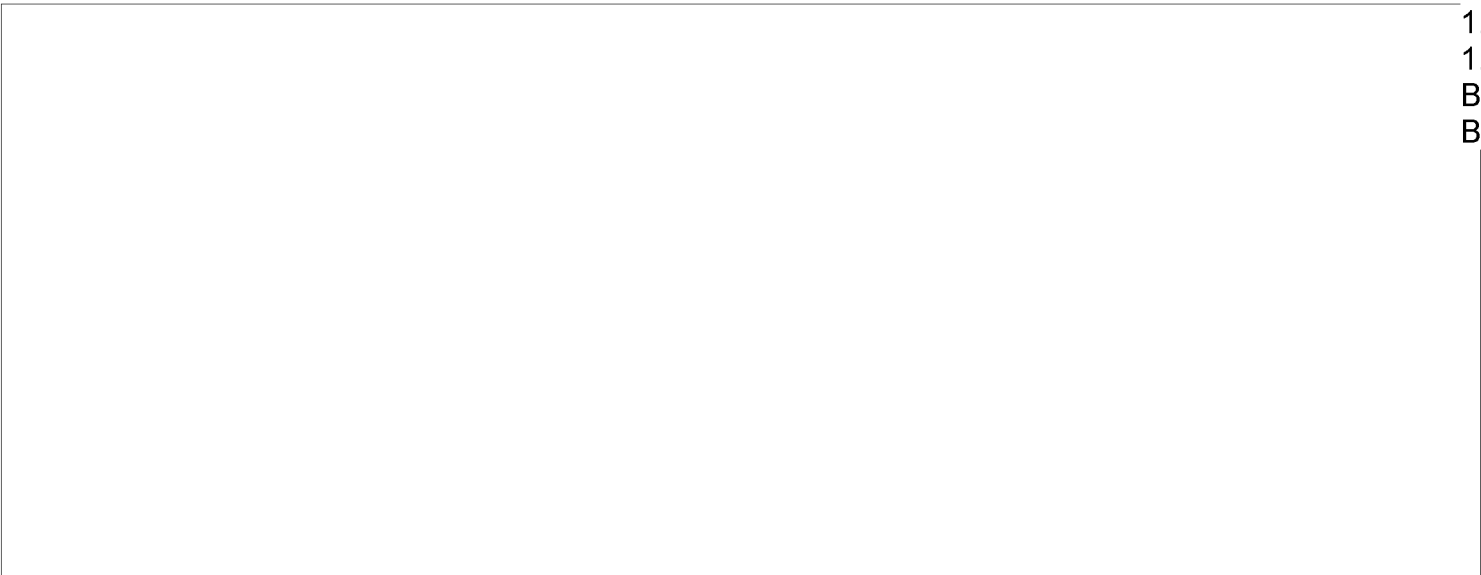

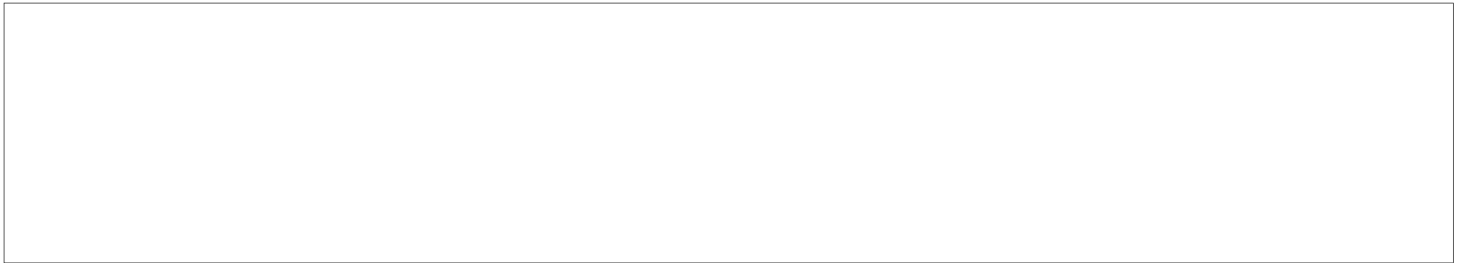

I'm sure you guys have planned our likely responses to Netanyahu's speech.

Just to pass along what they told me on the plane over (although they did not share draft language):

He will make his points about the need for presenting Iran with red lines, which he believes are the only thing that will make Iran stop its nuclear program, and in fact, will make it possible to avoid military action.
