NEA: im Jeffrey spoke with Maliki today. Maliki plans to speak with Allawi over the weekend. He seems to be feeling the pressure to get something done. Jack Lew will have an Iraq meeting tomorrow to discuss Diyala and Irbil.

PRM: The OAS has sent to the Department a critical draft report on U.S. practices in detaining immigrants. We have 30 days to send comments back to the OAS and we are coordinating with DHS to draft a response.

EEB: A draft ruling from the WTO indicates that we subsidize Boeing on the order of USD 20 billion.

WHA: The Colombia certification went to the Hill yesterday and so far the reaction has been positive, including a good Human Rights Watch assessment. H indicated, however, the Tim Rieser was unhappy with it and is withholding funding.

AF: Guinea's second round of presidential elections has been postponed. We are hoping the delay is no more than two weeks. Six workers were kidnapped at a mining facility in Niger. The fear is that they would be transferred to AQIM and then the prognosis would be dim.

EUR: Poll of European views of the United States and its foreign policy suggests only a slight slippage of Euros' views toward us: from 83 percent to 78 percent, but the headlines say "Europe cools on Obama."
