**Security** One bomb exploded in parking lot next to Embassy in Tbilisi; another unexploded – no casualties or Embassy damage; unclear if Embassy was target. There had been no previous threat information. Georgian authorities fully cooperating. Embassy Paris issued warden message to Americans in Paris warning of increased terrorist threat, though nothing targeting U.S. interests specifically. Violence in Karachi continues in wake of MQM leader assassination in London

**Congress** SFRC unanimously reported out UK/Australia Defense Trade Treaties; ratification will depend on passage of implementing legislation, which Berman is holding pending a deal on relaxed export controls on defense trade with Israel. NDAA failed; Senate now considering campaign finance reform. Clapper will brief Senate on recent intel; Rose and DoD will participate to provide context. L is still looking at documents Sen. Feinstein requested on CIA detentions. HASC testimony with Gates 9/30 now may not happen. Rich is exploring topics for possible breakfast next week – PSD on development may be a good one. We've now formally implemented requirement that all reports to the Congress, other than specifically granted exceptions, must be five pages or less.

**Iraq** Allawi appears to be softening demand to be PM; Jim J will see him today.
