To President Obama:

The Elders have accepted an invitation from North Korea to visit Pyongyang during the last week in April. Our itinerary has not been finalized, but we will probably make brief stops in China and South Korea. Our basic purposes will be to learn as much as possible about humanitarian problems, the political and military situation, and to encourage peace and denuclearization of the Peninsula.

Included in the trip will be Mary Robinson, Gro Brundtland, and Marti Ahtissari. It would be helpful if I could receive a briefing to help assure that our efforts are compatible with American policy.
