Attached is a condensed curriculum vitae and letters of recommendation that I have received.

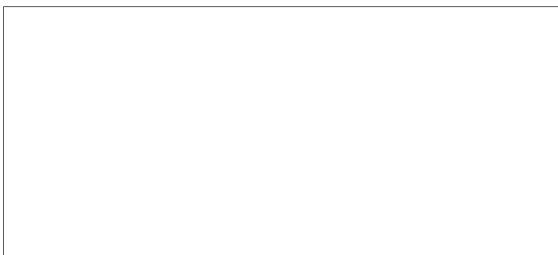
I seek reappointment as an Ambassador, and of course, appreciate any help you can give me.
