Thanks to some quick work by Ian Kelly, Diana Marvin and me, we found formulations to suit both the Greeks and Turks and so, success.

Congratulations to Diana and her hard-working delegation: we are well-launched on the next five years of cooperation under this important treaty regime, which together with CFE and Vienna Document 99, form the back-bone of the European conventional arms control system. This success puts in place a positive environment for next week's consultations on CFE here in Vienna and Moscow.
