Frank Ruggiero reports that Arghandab District Governor Jabar and one of his sons was killed in a suicide bomb in Kandahar City near the Governor's palace. The Governor will work with the IDLG on a contingency plan on who steps up to fill his shoes. Jabar was a good partner for us who has helped stabilize Arghandab, and has met most of our senior Embassy officials and many codels traveling to Arghandab. This attack coupled with the Nagahan bombing (wedding attack) of a couple nights ago confirms reports that the Taliban intend to step up attacks in Kandahar in anticipation of Hamkari.
