Nicole Ann Wilett and Colin Stuart Thomas-Jensen were married Saturday in West Tisbury, Mass., on Martha's Vineyard. The Rev. Judith E. Meyer, a Unitarian-Universalist minister, officiated at Nip n Tuck Farm.

The bride, 34, will use the surname Wilett-Jensen. She is the senior adviser and chief of staff at the United States Embassy in Pretoria, South Africa. From 2010 until January, she was a director for African affairs at the White House, where she was a member of the national security staff. She graduated from Syracuse and received a master's degree in public and international affairs from Indiana University.

She is the daughter of Felicity A. Nussbaum of Santa Monica, Calif., and J. Rene Wilett of Syracuse. The bride's father is a psychologist in private practice in Syracuse. Her mother is a distinguished professor of English at the University of California, Los Angeles.

The groom, 37, is a special adviser to Princeton Lyman, President Obama's envoy for Sudan and South Sudan. Mr. Thomas-Jensen is working from the embassy in Pretoria. He graduated from Pomona College in Claremont, Calif., and received a master's in African studies from the University of London.

He is the son of Sheila L. Thomas and John W. Jensen of Vadnais Heights, Minn. The groom's mother is a family therapist in private practice in St. Paul. His father is a software-design training specialist in the information technology division of the 3M Corporation in Maplewood, Minn.
