Holbrooke has been the driver of (non-military) strategic innovation in Afghanistan and Pakistan, including:

- *Defining a regional approach to Af/Pak, including the trilateral summit*

Afghanistan

- *Conceptualizing "Afghanization": a strategy focused on standing up the ANSF*

- *Reconciliation/reintegration*

- *International engagement and diplomacy*
 - Special reps from more than 20 countries
 - Engagement with Arab allies, China, India, and Turkey

Pakistan

- *Economic and energy assistance strategy for Pakistan*
 - Sending Lipton's team; launching a major new energy initiative

Holbrooke has assembled an unprecedented team to carry out the work

- Whole-of-government team in DC
- Reorganized the U.S. mission in Kabul, including recruiting Eikenberry and top talent and implementing a new paradigm for assistance
