Hi Peter, fascinating to watch MB's response last couple days. I spent yesterday with 4 candidates and youth activists in Dumyat, Belqas, and Mansoura. I think elections will happen. MB and Salafis are pushing hard. And nearly every other organized force is more or less in agreement, with some calling for, at most, a 1-2 week delay. It's not a popular opinion, but i don't think most Egyptians are with the protesters. Tantawi's speech gave most people most of what they wanted.

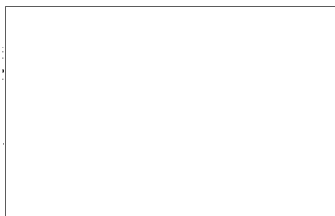
