I hope you are well. I am very proud of your remarkable work. You may remember that during the Clinton Administration I was Under Secretary of State for Economic, Business, and Agricultural Affairs and I was the chief U.S. negotiator for the Kyoto Protocol. Todd Stern and Jonathan Pershing were key parts of my team.

I have been doing pro bono representation of a remarkable organization fronted by Jeff Horowitz, Avoided Deforestation Partners, which combines many of the country's major environmental groups with a number of large electric utility companies. We are dedicated to reducing the rate of global deforestation, which is a major contribution to greater gas emissions.
