KABUL (AP) - The Afghan attorney general's office says it has launched an investigation into misconduct at Afghanistan's largest bank, which nearly collapsed in 2010 after a management shake-up and corruption scandal.

A spokesman for the attorney general's office says the Afghan Central Bank sent a five-page letter to Attorney General Alako saying certain groups should be investigated for their role in allowing Kabul Bank to fall into crisis.
