In trying to build this new media event we've encountered two production/technical issues: 1) you need to be at Aljazeera's DC studio 2) it needs to be in the 45 minute range. On #2, I know from Huma that you see this as something that lasts 30 minutes tops. Assuming that's still the case, what I'd do is go back to AJ, tell them we can do it there but it needs to be 30 mins max, otherwise we can't do it. If they say yes, great, if not, we can instead just tape three straight up interviews with Aljazeera, Alarabiya, Alhurra on Monday, and then work on a simplified new media event for sometime later in the week - maybe Tuesday tied to the Internet Freedom speech.
