SANAA, Sept 19 (Reuters) - Soldiers opposed to President Ali Abdullah Saleh have reached a ceasefire with government forces, an opposition source said on Monday, after fierce gun battles erupted during a crackdown on pro-democracy protesters,

"They've reached a ceasefire agreement between the president's forces and those of (defected) General Ali Mohsen's forces," an opposition source told Reuters.

A top ruling party official told Reuters he had not been informed of a deal but expected an agreement later on Monday night.
